



New Year's Resolutions- Every year, we all make New Year's Resolutions. This year make a few resolutions that strengthen your faith.

Pray the Rosary daily or weekly -The rosary allows us to reflect on the life of Jesus and Mary. We pray with the scriptures. At Fatima, Mary asked us to pray for peace in the world. You can begin the rosary with a decade.

Pray the Lectio Divina or "Holy Reading" The Lectio Divinia is a way of praying using passages in the bible. The four stages of this prayer are simply reading a passage from the bible, reflecting on the passage (meditating), respond turning to pray for needs and contemplation of the meaning of the passage.
