The Jubilee of Deacons February 23, 2025

The Holy See has designated a number of Jubilee Days throughout 2025 to recognize and celebrate different groups of people and various ministries in the Church. The Jubilee of Deacons will be held from Friday, February 21, to Sunday, February 23, 2025. The diaconate is one of three degrees in ordained ministry - bishops, priests, and deacons. Since the Second Vatican Council, the Latin-rite Church has restored the diaconate "as a proper and permanent rank of the hierarchy." Deacons preparing for the priesthood are transitional deacons, while those not planning to be ordained priests are permanent deacons. Permanent diaconate can be conferred on a single or married man. If he is married, he must be so before receiving the diaconate.

Deacons embrace the ministry of word, ministry of liturgy, and works of charity which, in their turn, are carried into daily life. Depending on the circumstances, one or another of these may receive particular emphasis in an individual deacon's work but these three ministries are inseparably joined together as one in the service of God's redemptive plan.

In his 2021 address to deacons, Pope Francis expressed a greater focus on cultivating humility and generosity in ministry. Speaking to them, the Holy Father says he expects humble deacons, letting all good be a secret between him and God; he expects deacons to be good spouses, fathers, and grandfathers, inspiring others with their witness of joy in everything without complaining; he expects deacons to be sentinels, to both know the face of the poor and also help the Christian faithful recognize Jesus in them.

The deacon exercises his ministry within the communion and mission of a diocesan Church and in direct relationship with his diocesan bishop, under whose authority he is assigned, as a collaborator in the service of God's people. As collaborators in ministry, serving alongside priests, deacons participate in the one apostolic ministry bestowed by Christ upon the Apostles and their successors. "The diaconate is not an abridged or substitute form of the priesthood; it is a full order in its own right."

In this Jubilee Year, do everything with humility, with joy without complaining, and in radical hospitality to the poor and marginalized. Allow the love of Jesus to flow from you, as you humbly serve others as missionary disciples. Listen with tender care and affection to the needs of others, especially the poor in your community. 

The Feast of the Chair of St. Peter and the 6th Sunday of Ordinary Time

Chair of St. Peter February 22nd

On February 22nd, the Church celebrates the role of the Pope, Vicar of Christ, beginning with St. Peter and continuing through Pope Francis. The "chair" comes from the Latin word cathedra meaning seat of the government.

In the Gospel of Matthew 16:15-18, Jesus asks the Twelve Apostles, "Who do you say that I am?" Peter responded that Jesus was the son of the living God. Jesus responded to Peter, "Blessed art you, Simon son of Jonah. For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my heavenly Father" (v. 17). Peter's heavenly response showed that he will lead the apostles and be the "rock" of Church. Jesus shared that the Church will be so rock solid that "the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it" (v. 18).

After the resurrection in John 21:15-17, Jesus confirms Peter's primacy over the other apostles as well as authority over His Church. He gives Peter the keys to the kingdom, telling him to: "Feed my lambs.... Feed my sheep." This authority was passed on to Peter's successors. On this feast day, the universal Church acknowledges that St. Peter was the first pope and that his mission continues through the Holy Father today. There is an actual Chair in St. Peter's Basilica at the Vatican City.

The Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time February 23

The Seventh Sunday focuses on mercy, justice, and attitudes. We are invited to emulate God's mercy, rephrain from Judgement and extend forgiveness to others. These are appropriate themes for 2025 shared in the Old Testament reading of 1 Samuel 26, "The Lord will reward each man for his justice and faithfulness." Where David spares Saul's life, Psalm 103 call," The Lord is kind and merciful." The Gospel, *Luke 6:28-28* opens with Jesus saying to his disciples, "love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for for those who mistreat you." Let us turn the other cheek and open our hearts to follow Jesus' commandment, "Love one and another, even as I have loved you. "John 13:35
