GOSPEL MEDITATION ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE October 20, 2024 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

From a young age, I loved winning at sports. I confess that winning was a bit of an addiction. It was probably coming from a deep desire for attention and affirmation from others. Nevertheless, it was a driving motivation for me. Baseball, soccer, track, table tennis, and whatever else I could find was a chance to win. Competition was my obsession.

Another John, and his brother James, demonstrate a kind of wildly competitive obsession when they dare to say to Jesus: **“Grant us to sit, one at your right hand and one at your left, in your glory”** (Mark 10:37). Their audacity arouses an indignant reaction from the other apostles, who are clearly raw that these two are out to win the highest spots.

How does Jesus respond to us in our desires for greatness? The same way he does to James and John. He does not criticize them for their desire for glory. But he does highlight their ignorance (**“you do not know what you are asking.”**). Then he invites them to be champions of true greatness: by drinking not the cup of worldly victory, but his cup of self-giving suffering love, to be the **“slave of all.”** The true winners are slaves of love. This week, dare to tell Jesus what your ambitions truly are. Hear him call you to an even greater victory.

You can sign up for a daily reflection at [Dynamic Catholic.com](http://DynamicCatholic.com).

Attend Mass Regularly

The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Catholic faith. Regular attendance at Mass is crucial to growing closer to Christ. It's not just about fulfilling an obligation — it's an opportunity to receive the Body and Blood of our Lord and Savior.

Loyola Press offers a question and prayer sheet to reflect on Sunday's mass. You can sign up for Sunday Connection for free at LoyolaPress.com/Sundayconnection.

Study the Bible, get involved in an Adult Faith Formation program and read Catholic Literature. Spiritual Growth abounds in studying the Word of God. There are online programs, study bibles, bible groups and classes available to you.

You can find free resources at the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' New American Bible online at www.bible.usccb.org/bible. There are several programs available in person and online for members of our Catholic Community. This month parishioners can study the Gospel according to Mark as a group. The fee is \$10 for materials and you can contact me at the address above to sign up. Don't worry if you have missed a session, we will catch you up.

Another great source of materials is FranciscanAtHome.org Their programs are free to you. You can attend a course, lecture, retreat, or seminar online and work at your own pace. Simply go to the site and follow the steps to set up your account.

Look for our book study on the *33 Days of Eucharistic Glory* during Advent. Kick off the new year with a book study *Beautiful Hope*.

Grow closer to Christ Growing in your faith is a lifelong process. Together we can deepen your understanding of the teachings of the Church and your relationship to God.
